

# The town of Arkelstorp

## – *familiar to large companies*

**MANY LARGE** manufacturing companies are familiar with the town of Arkelstorp, 20 km north of Kristianstad. From this town, many of these companies have purchased total solutions for internal transport and material handling technology.

These structures and solutions are AB Vecto's speciality. ABB, Scania, Saab, Volvo, Svedala, Sandvik, ITT Flygt, Procordia, Magneti Marelli, Autoliv and many, many others are all aware of that.

'We have specialised by offering complete solutions to different problems within transport and material handling from our little 'knowledge house' in the centre of the town,' says Lars Persson, MD and part-owner of AB Vecto. Ownership of the remaining half is shared equally between Knislinge Mekaniska Verkstad (KVM) and Levins in Hässleholm.

AB Vecto has five permanent employees – employees who are largely dedicated to structures and solutions.

'We buy or subcontract the materials for the conveyor belts, transporters, conveyor systems and other transport systems we make,' says Lars Persson.

Assembly, fitting and test-running is carried out here in our workshop. Fitters and other personnel are hired in for this, mostly from the part-owners – KVM and, for electrical and control systems, Levins.

'The assignments are very varied. Quite often the transport solutions are a supplement to robotic operation.
